Call for Applications: Consultant for Final External Evaluation

The Women's Support Center is seeking a qualified consultant to conduct the final external evaluation of a three-year project funded by the United Nations Trust Fund aimed at preventing and addressing domestic violence in Armenia. The consultant will be responsible for assessing the project's impact, effectiveness, and sustainability, as well as providing recommendations for future programming.

Key Responsibilities:

- Conduct a comprehensive evaluation of the project, including reviewing project documents and data, conducting interviews and focus groups, and analyzing findings.
- Assess the project's achievements against its objectives and KPIs.
- Provide recommendations for future programming based on evaluation findings.

Qualifications:

- At least 5 years' experience in conducting external evaluations, with mixed-methods evaluation skills and having flexibility in using non-traditional and innovative evaluation methods
- Expertise in gender and human-rights based approaches to evaluation and issues of violence against women and girls
- A strong commitment to delivering timely and high-quality results, i.e. credible evaluation and its report that can be used
- · A strong team leadership and management track record, as well as interpersonal and communication skills to help ensure that the evaluation is understood and used
- Language proficiency: fluency in English and Armenian is mandatory

Interested candidates should submit their CV, motivation letter, and an estimated cost for carrying out the evaluation service to wsc.armenia@gmail.com by March 25, 2024. Shortlisted candidates will be contacted for an interview.

This consultancy is expected to start on April 1, 2024, and last for 40 days over a period of 3 months. The consultant will be expected to travel to various regions in Armenia as part of the evaluation process.
